What is digital transformation, anyhow?

"Digital transformation" is a bit of a buzzword, but the concept is simple. It's using technology to change things in your business to get better results. Digital projects can take many forms, including e-commerce, digital marketing, robotics, cloud computing, analytics, ERP solutions, and more.

What is Digital Boost 2.0?

give funding to work with a qualified technology
provider to create a digital strategy. Think of
it as the roadmap that will guide your digital
transformation journey. Along with technology
recommendations, the strategy will look at other
crucial areas of your business, including:

People: Is your leadership aligned? Do you have the right people and skillsets on your team? How will digital impact how your employees deliver services or your customers receive them?

Process: What do you need to do differently to get the most out of your technology?

Culture: How will these changes affect company culture? Will they be embraced or resisted?

Digital transformation is as much about change management and business strategy as technology.

Digital Boost 2.0 will reimburse 75% of \$26,600 to a maximum of \$20,000 per company to do this digital strategy and roadmap. If the project doesn't cost \$26,600, leftover funding can go towards implementing your first project from your roadmap.
